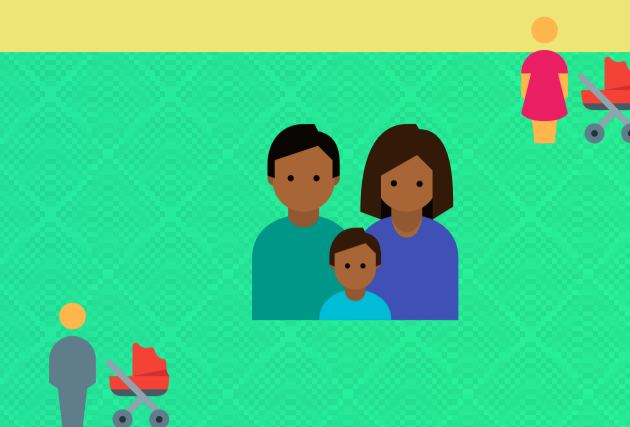
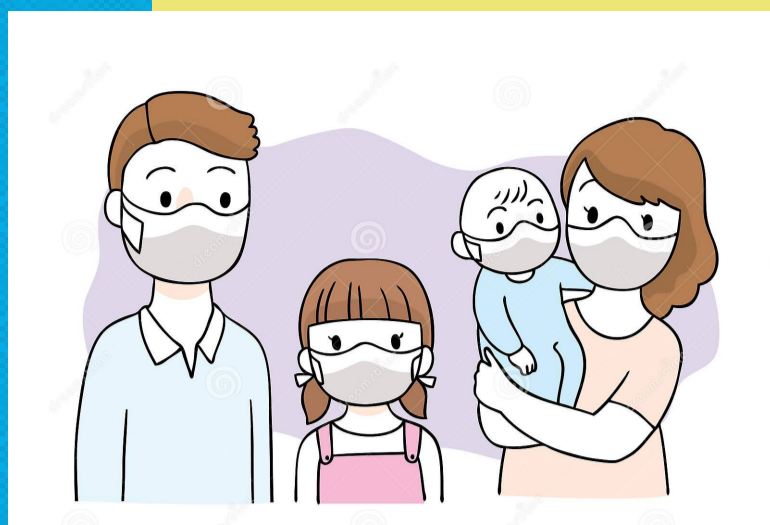


Parent-child interactions during the Covid-19 Pandemic: The views of Indian mothers and fathers

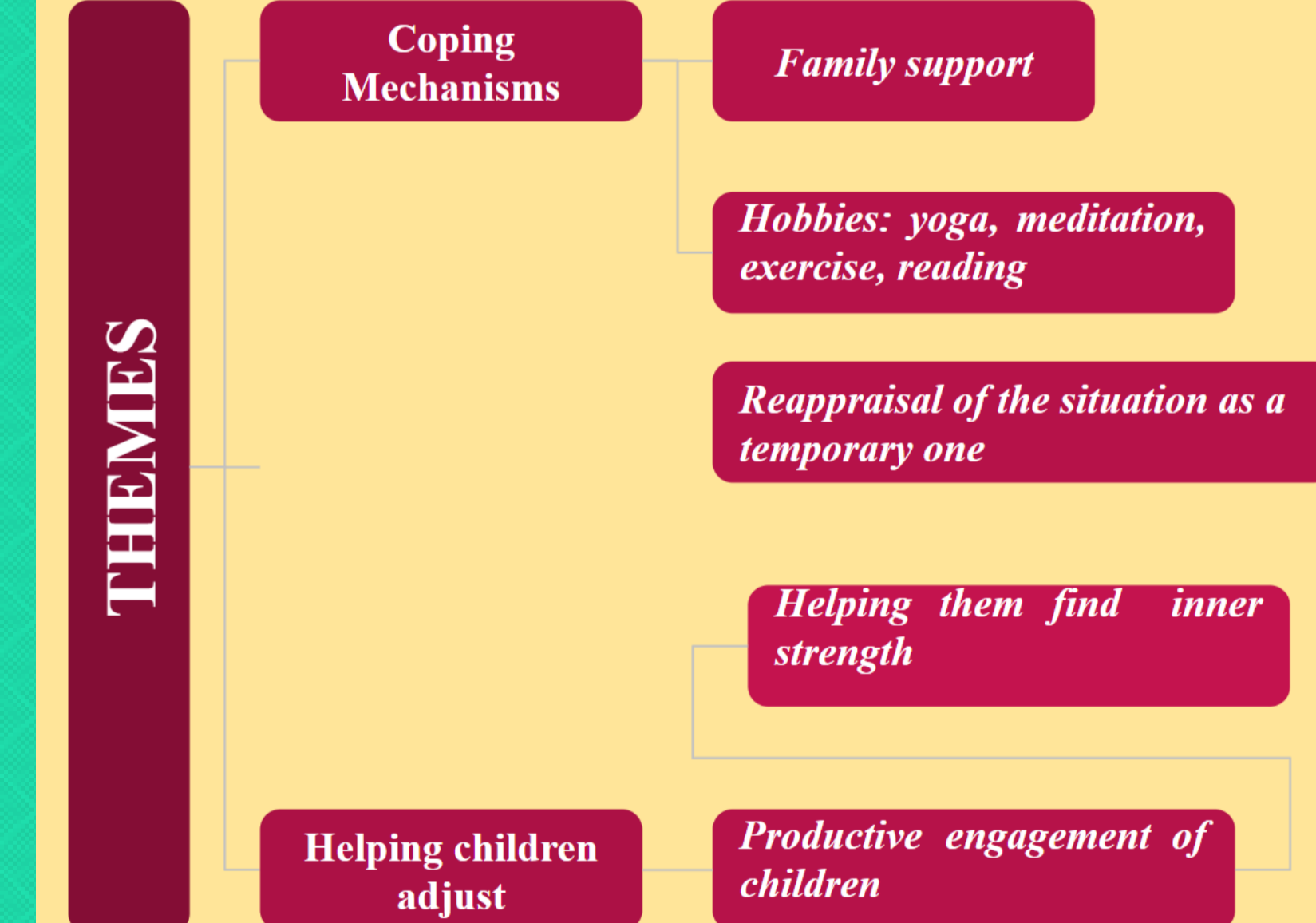
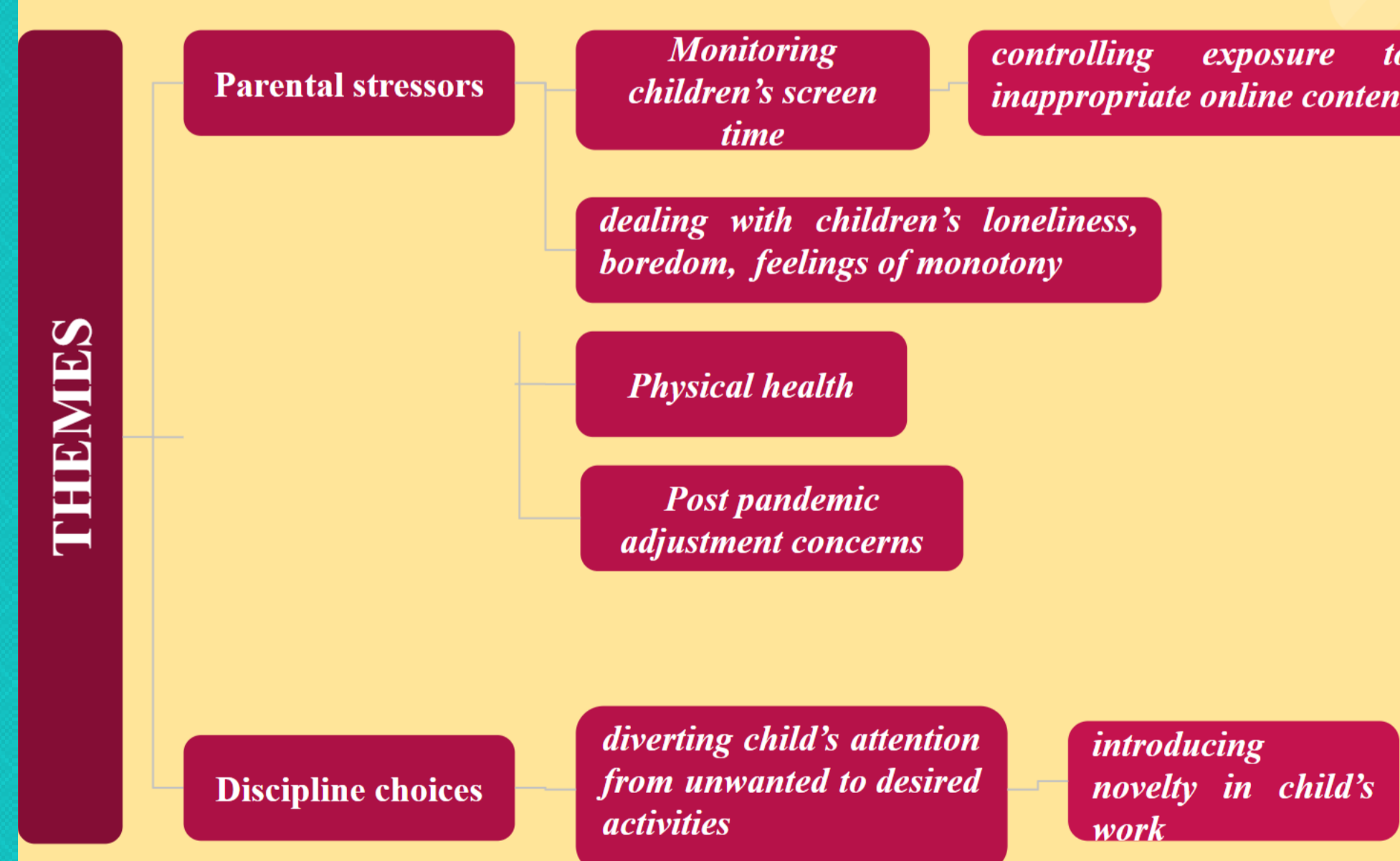
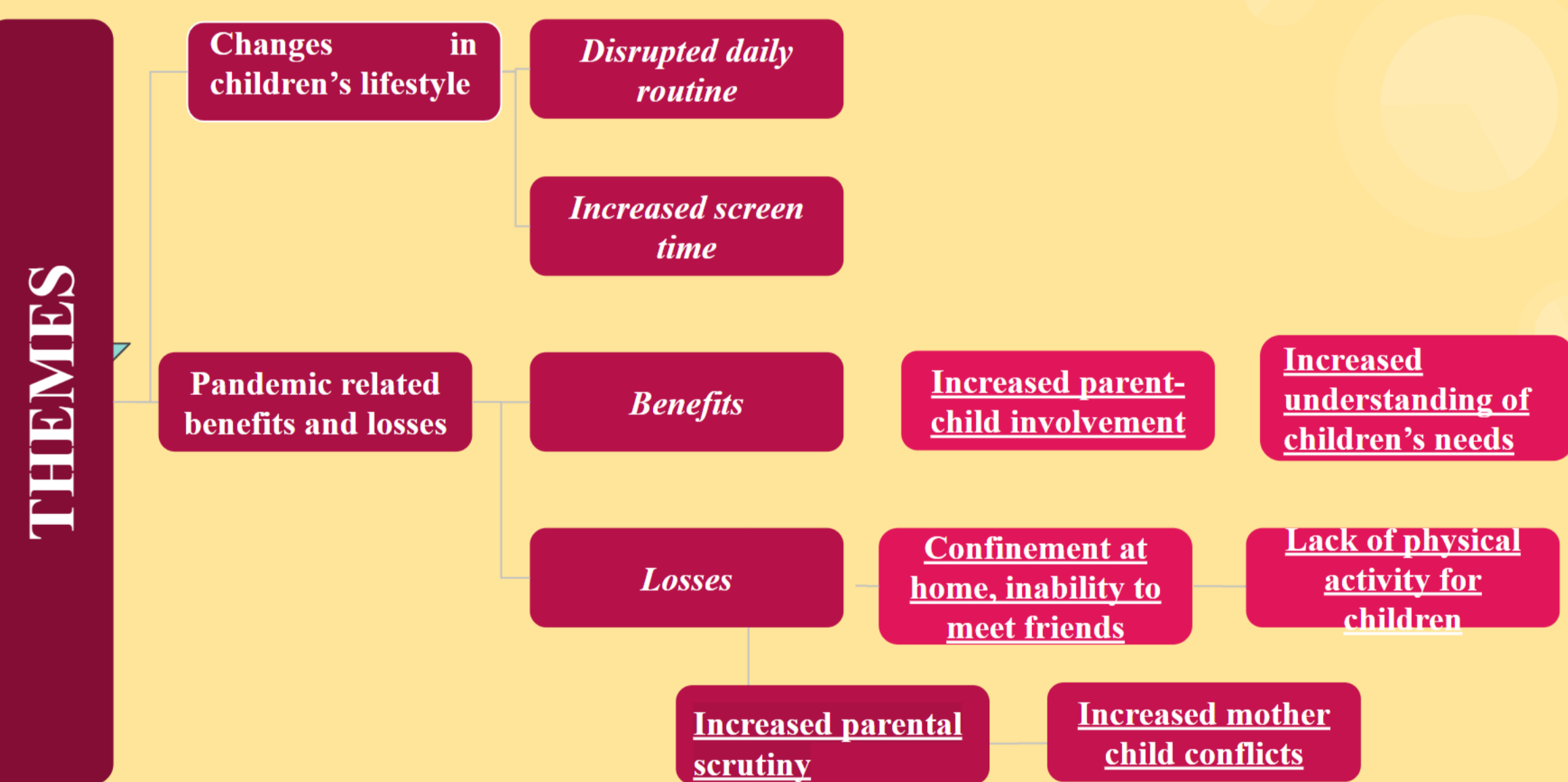


METHOD



- ◆ Convenience and snowball sampling techniques
- Semi-structured interviews were used to unearth perceptions regarding the impact of the pandemic on family routines, parenting styles, levels of parent-child conflict and cohesion
- ◆ Thematic analysis (Clarke & Braun, 2006).

LIMITATIONS

- ◆ Limited sample generalizability
- ◆ Telephonic interviews compromised nonverbal data
- ◆ Scope of researcher's bias

FUTURE DIRECTIONS

- ◆ Sample diversification - inclusion of single parents, queer couples, disabled parents
- ◆ Longitudinal studies to capture long term impacts
